



Teacher: Frequently Asked Questions

When can I take my students on a fieldtrip? Fieldtrips can begin any time after 10:00am, Tuesday-Friday.

How far in advance should I book my fieldtrip? Please allow at least 30 days before you would like to visit.

How much do fieldtrips cost for the exhibits and robot lab? There is a \$3 fee for each student for groups of at least 10 or more.

How long is a fieldtrip? For the exhibits and Robot Lab, please allow 2-3 hours. Students will rotate between four learning areas. For the Challenger Learning Center, please allow 2 hours.

How much is a simulated mission in the Challenger Learning Center? The flat fee for this experience is \$350. Please contact us to inquire about special discounts.

How many students can you accommodate at a time? You may book up to 120 students for the exhibits and Robot Lab. Please split the students into four equal groups. The Challenger Learning Center accommodates groups of 16-36 for each mission.

What is the minimum age for the exhibits? Our exhibits are engaging for all age groups and there is no minimum requirement.

What is the minimum age for the Challenger Learning Center? This experience is best suited for grades 5 and up.

What is the minimum age for the Robot Lab? This experience is best suited for grades 2 and up.

Can we eat lunch there? Yes, you may bring lunches and enjoy them outside the Space Center as no food or drink is allowed inside. We are located next to a sports park with grass as well.

What is the student to chaperone ratio? We require one chaperone for every ten students.
